#### DPA & The IB Primary Years Programme

At DPA we are beginning to implement the PYP (Primary Years Programme) of the IB (International Baccalaureate) Curriculum. This forms the basis of teaching and learning for subjects other than English, Maths and Reading. The aim of the IB PYP is to develop internationally minded people who, recognising their common humanity and shared guardianship of the planet, help to create a better and more peaceful world.

#### How We Express Ourselves

Our whole school theme is '**How We Express Ourselves.**' In Year 6, our inquiry statement is 'People may use creativity to express uniqueness'.



#### English

- No Wasted Weeks transition project studying the works of famous English authors.

#### During our PYP learning we will be investigating:

- How I can be more creative.
- What makes me unique
- Why diversity exists.

#### Maths

- Cross Curricular work based around the analysis of a humanitarian relief response to a natural disaster.

#### PYP Home Learning

Please support your child to express their uniqueness!

Children should complete a piece of work based on a theme of 'Robin Hood' that best expresses their creative skill. This could be a piece of art, a poem, a story or a project of their choosing. To be handed in once it is complete.

#### PE

PE lessons are on Thursday. This term the children are playing a variety of Rounders based games. Children need to make sure they have PE kits in school every day in case of impromptu PE sessions.

#### Reading, Spellings, Mathletics

Spellings will not be set this term. Children should continue to read daily. 'Buster's Book Club' is still ongoing and the total numbers of minutes read will still be collected on a weekly basis. Mathletics homework has been set to ensure that the children maintain their mathematics skills.
